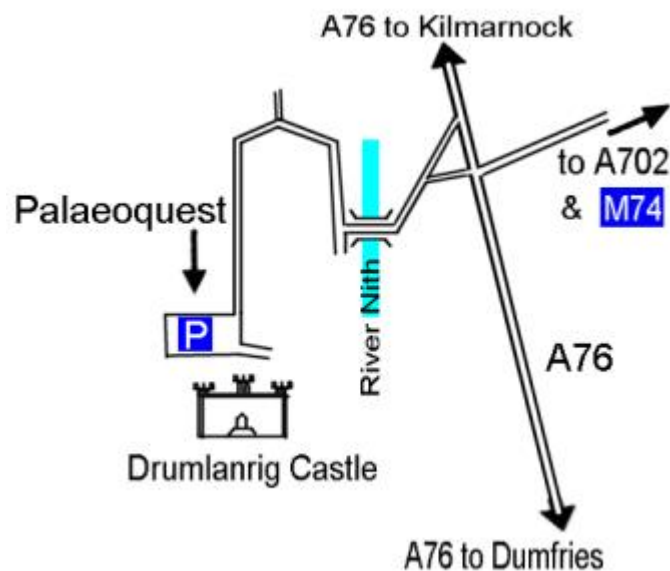


How to get to us

We are based at Drumlanrig except for advanced work.

Drumlanrig Castle lies on the A76 between Kilmarnock and Dumfries.

From the M74 take junction 14 (A702) and follow signs for Dumfries, Carronbridge and Drumlanrig Castle.



What you will need to bring...

For Camps

Medicines: (self or parental etc. administration only) A midge repellent that works for you is recommended.

Outdoor clothes: Sufficient for length of stay and season.
Please use your own experienced judgement, choose from list or contact us for advice.

- Waterproof coat
- Walking/hiking boots preferred
- Warm clothes and changes of clothes
- Warm hat and gloves
- A sleeping bag.
- Personal toiletries etc.
- Your normal outdoor first aid kit

Please note: all non-schools courses will require the following,

Stone-working & flint-knapping: Please bring strong leather or gardening gloves and safety glasses.

Safety glasses are available from Palaeoquest at £5:00

Food:

Food is supplied, but people may wish to supplement a stone-age diet with their own food/snacks.

Vegetarian food is available of course

Please contact us if you have special dietary needs.

Students on accredited courses 2, 3 and 4 may rely on their own judgement

For skills courses

All courses: Outdoor clothes (as above) though courses may be held indoors by prior arrangement, in winter or in bad weather..

For bow-making: tools are supplied but you may wish to bring your own axe and knife.
