

What you will need to bring...

For Camps

- Medicines:** (self or parental etc. administration only) A midge repellent that works for you is recommended.
- Outdoor clothes:** Sufficient for length of stay and season
A sleeping bag.
Personal toiletries etc.
- Food:** Food is supplied, but people may wish to supplement a stone-age diet with their own food/snacks.
Vegetarian food is available of course
Please contact us if you have special dietary needs.

Students on accredited courses 2, 3 and 4 may rely on their own judgement

For skills courses

- Outdoor clothes:** All courses, except in bad weather.
- For bow-making:** tools are supplied but you may wish to bring your own axe and knife.
- Stone-working & flint-knapping:** Strong leather or gardening gloves and safety glasses.
